### FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

#### WHAT DOES THIS DEVELOPMENT CONSIST OF?

Dexus and Frasers Property will deliver the development, this will include new commercial buildings, retail and hospitality.

Central Place Sydney will be Sydney's most significant CBD development in over a decade, providing employment space critical to the NSW economic recovery. The development will transform the western edge of Central Station. The proposal includes:

- up to 150,000 square metres of workspace across two towers and a podium building
- an Integrated Distribution Facility that unlocks future over-station development, facilitating the renewal of Central Station
- comprehensive public realm improvements that will redefine the experience of over 20 million pedestrians every year

#### WHAT IS THE PURPOSE OF THESE WORKSHOPS?

These workshops will inform us about the Aboriginal culture and heritage of the CBD and Central areas. This opportunity aims to integrate an Aboriginal narrative within the new development. Through this engagement we aim to:

- Highlight opportunities for the project to understand the Aboriginal context (cultural, physical and spiritual)
- Highlight opportunities to consider how Aboriginal culture and heritage can be considered
- Discuss what the local community think should be considered by the project team as it continues to develop the project.

Balarinji is a leading Aboriginal-owned strategy and design agency that has been based in Sydney for 20 years. Our aim for the session is to listen to the community about how it wants to see the project develop a deeper understanding of the Aboriginal cultural significance of Central Place Sydney.
