## **FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS**

#### WHAT DOES THE PROPOSED REDEVELOPMENT CONSIST OF?

55 Pitt Street will deliver approximately 70,000 square metres of office area, with ground level retail spaces, surrounding public spaces as well as an an upgrade to the Telstra Exchange and Ausgrid Substation within the site. The project will provide a flexible, adaptable and connected workplace which responds to a contemporary and modern environment designed for the needs of the occupants of 55 Pitt Street. The project will fuse smart and environmental design with a tailored strategy for retail and Public art on the ground level to bring a vibrancy to the public spaces and overall precinct.

#### WHAT IS THE PURPOSE OF THIS WORKSHOP?

The purpose of these workshops is to develop a body of artwork to inform the project team about the Aboriginal cultural heritage of 55 Pitt Street and the surrounding area.

Through this engagement we aim to:

- Highlight opportunities for the project to understand the Aboriginal context (cultural, physical and spiritual)
- Highlight opportunities to consider how Aboriginal culture and heritage can be considered
- Discuss what the local community think should be considered by the project team as it continues to develop the project.
